Advanced Commercial HVAC/R

Estimating II (Virtual Class)

6 Sessions - Tuesdays - March 7, 14, 21, 28, and April 4 and 11

The course will focus on estimating for Mechanical Contracting, including piping, equipment, fixtures, and specialty takes-offs, as well as putting together an entire estimate. *This course is limited to those who have completed the Blueprint Reading & Estimating Class.*

Basic Computerized Scheduling

Successful project execution <u>requires</u> adequate planning and tracking. This allows you to minimize job site inefficiency, accurately predict workforce requirements, and provide documentation to allow you to get paid for changes and claims caused by others. This course will make you more aware of the time-related costs that impact your projects and, using Microsoft Project 2013 scheduling software, how to accurately schedule your jobs. In addition, you will learn how to document and recover your real costs caused by delays, changes, etc., thereby improving your projects' profitability. This course is limited to 12 people.
